To assist families and young adults to access snow sports with the assistance of Disabled Wintersports Australia trained guides.

About

Snow Camp is supported by a physiotherapist and OT, and There are places 3 x standing skiers. We try to offer these positions to new families each year i.e. families that have not taken part in Snow Camp previously. People who would like to come on the camp as Sit skiers are able to register to be on the waiting list for future camps.

Who

- Current Kids+ Participants aged 9 yrs or over (for equipment sizing)
- Would be able to stand on either leg for 2-3 seconds
- Participants are required to register as Members of DWA. Cost may funded by NDIS
- Must have a carer/family member traveling with them if under 18 yrs or require assistance for personal care.
- Additional family members are welcome
