Children and their families are invited to take part in speech therapy research

Children who:

- have cerebral palsy
- are 8-14 years old
- have moderate to severe speech difficulty

Therapy will be on telehealth



This research tries to find out if Rapid Syllable Transition Treatment (ReST) improves speech with children with cerebral palsy and makes it easier for them to take part in daily conversations.

Please note that the assessments and therapy do not incur cost or NDIS funding.

Children who attend this study, will receive

- A comprehensive speech assessment
- 6 weeks of speech therapy aiming to develop clearer speech
